This voice helps readers to:
☐ Relate to the text
☐ Make connections between the text and the reader
☐ Ask questions
☐ Give opinions
☐ Talk back to the text
☐ Remember what is read
Reciting voice (waste of time voice)
This voice causes readers to:
☐ Lose track of what is being read
☐ Stray from the text
☐ Forget what is read
☐ Not care about the reading
Turn off the reciting voice by rereading and giving yourself a job or a purpose for reading.
Some purposes are:
Ask a question
Look for the answer to a question
Make a connection
Look for clues to help draw an inference
Retell what has been read
Try to visualize a picture
